

Highlands-Cashiers Land Trust Property: Dixon Woods Park

Dixon Woods is one of the flattest hikes in Highlands, with an easy access parking area. This is a pleasant walk around a small pond and through oak forests. Enjoy a picnic at the picnic table, or on one of the benches overlooking the water. The network of trails total about 1.7 miles, with variable lengths.



Directions to Dixon Woods:

From Highlands, NC:


From downtown Highlands, NC follow Main Street towards Mountain Fresh Grocery. Continue straight on Horse Cove Road. (Pass the Highlands Biological Station and Ravenel Park). After about 0.8 miles, take a sharp left turn onto Bowery Road. Go about 1.3 miles on Bowery Road, and there is a designated gravel parking lot on the right. If you see Split Rail Row Road, you've gone too far. **(About 2 miles total).**

From Cashiers, NC:

Head towards Highlands, NC on US64 West for about 9.8 miles. Continue straight onto South 4th Street, and turn left onto Main Street. See above directions from Highlands, NC. **(About 12.4 miles total).**







Note:

- There is a network of trails, all blazed with a different color (White, Blue, Green, Orange, and Red). Only the White, Green, and Orange trails have loops. The Blue and Red trails connect to other trails.
- The Orange Trail crosses over two roads: Dixon Drive and Split Rail Row Road.
