## Materials you will need:

- Plater of Paris
- A plastic sandwich baggie
- A small cup of water
- Small shovel or utensil




















**4.Let it harden:** Let it sit for 30 minutes to 1 hour and check if the cast has hardened. Wait until it has hardened completely before you remove it. If conditions are cold and wet this may take longer. You can even let it sit overnight if it's in a place where it will be protected.

**5. Scoop it out:** Once the cast is dry, dig around and under the cast to get it out of the ground then brush off the dirt. Avoid trying to pry it out of the ground it's still fragile. Wrap it in paper towels and let it dry overnight. After drying for another day or so you can wipe the cast with a wet cloth to remove the rest of the dirt.
